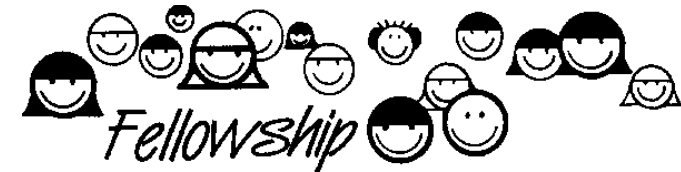

Children and young people of all ages are welcome at St Paul's.

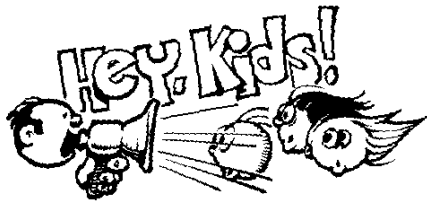
We are an intergenerational parish where a loving connection is fostered between people of all ages.

CHILDREN'S TALK

Before going to Sunday School there is a children's talk towards the beginning of the 10.00 a.m. worship service.

Classes are provided during the worship service for children from pre-school to grade 6.

TINY TOTS CHURCH

Tiny Tots Church is held at 4.00 p.m. on the fourth Sunday of each month in the Church.

Its 'worship that's relaxed and friendly for young children (0 - 5 years) their parents, grandparents, family and friends' and within the context of 30 - 40 minutes.

There are lively songs, a story, a craft activity and prayers. Afterwards, we have a cordial, a hot drink and something to eat in the Parish Centre.
