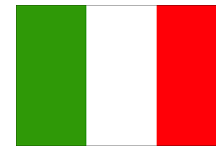

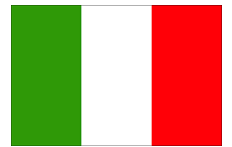
2. Feel for the people we most avoid,

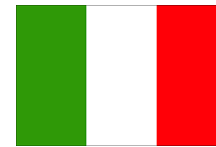

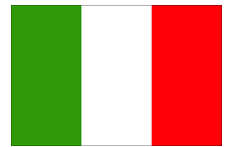
